## **EU.WATER**

### **“TRANSNATIONAL INTEGRATED MANAGEMENT OF WATER RESOURCES IN AGRICULTURE FOR EMERGENCY CONTROL OF EUROPEAN WATER”**

#### **DELEGATION IAE, BELGRADE AT THE SIXTH SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL PARTNERSHIP FORUM EU WATER between 26<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2012 IN BUCHAREST (ROMANIA)**

At the sixth scientific and partnership forum in Bucharest, Romania, which took place in hotel “Novotel”, from 25th to 28th January 2012., the delegation of the Institute of Agricultural Economics, represented MA Velibor Potrebić, research associate and Marijana Jovanović B.Sc, research assistant. International meeting was organized within the regular activities on the project EU.WATER – „Transnational integrated management of water resources in agriculture for the EU WATER emergency control”.

The meeting was opened by Mr Valery Tabara, the Minister of Agriculture of Romania. In welcome speech he pointed out the importance of adapting the Romanian rural economy in European agricultural practices, as well as the need for establishing a national strategy for sustainable development and address the current problems of water pollution and soil pollution with nitrates and nitrite from agricultural practice.

On the meeting also was mentioned the results achieved so far by the Member States and participating in the project. Special emphasis is put on the current implementation of the Nitrates Directive 91/676, Water Framework Directive 2000/60, as well as methods to reduce water and land pollution with nitrates and nitrites from agricultural practices. Representatives of the leading partners of the Province of Ferrara in Italy have been present suggestion on how to make a final report on project (Layman Report and Green Book). At the end of meeting, were made the decision and conclusion of the final conference which should be held 23th and 24th April in Budapest, Hungary.



#### **IN APRIL 2012 HELD SAMPLING OF SOIL AND WATER AT THE TERRITORY OF PANCEVO CITY**

PDS Institute "TAMIS" in the period between 01<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2012 completed sampling of soil and water in the City of Pancevo in 12 local communities.

Research carried out after the activities that the IEP, Belgrade had on the education the local population regarding EUWATER project (introduction local seikholders with EU Directives - Nitrate Directive 91/676 and the Water Directive 60/2000) during the three-year of project period.

Results of laboratory analysis and research will be elaborated in detail in the "Study II", which the Institute of Agricultural Economics from Belgrade will announce the end of September 2012.

Also, this will be the basis to assess how the project had EUWATER impact on local stakeholders at the territory of Pancevo.

#### **DELEGATION IAE, BELGRADE PARTICIPATED AT SEVENTH SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL PARTNERSHIP FORUM - EU WATER, 23<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>. APRILE 2012 IN BUDAPEST (HUNGARY)**

Delegation of the Institute of Agricultural Economics from Belgrade in the period from 23 to 25 April 2012 was in Budapest (Hungary), the "Seventh partners scientific and technical forum" within the regular activities the project EU.WATER - "*Transnational integrated management of water resources in agriculture for emergency control of European waters.*" This was also the final conference of the project.

The conference have been held at the Hotel "Gellert" in Budapest in the period from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> April 2012. Participants exchanged experiences in previous work on the project and rated the achieved results within the planned work packages during the project.

On the last day of the conference, IAE delegation had presentation about the implementation of knowledge gained through participation in EUWATER project. Title of presentation was "Entering the EU Countries' actions to address eco-friendly agricultural practices."



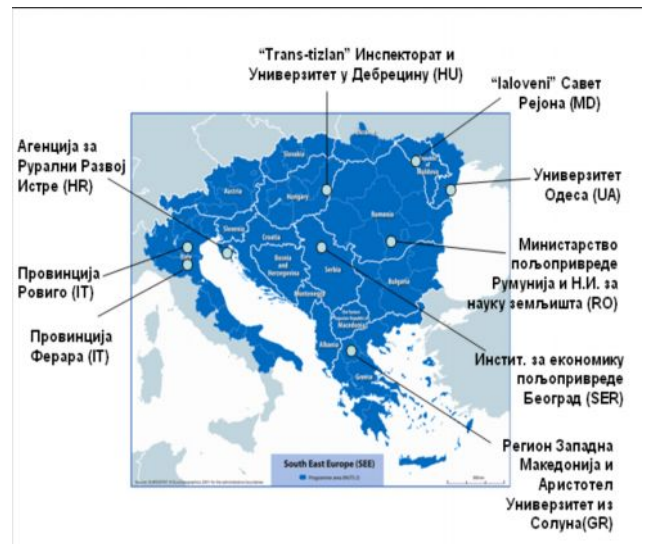
